

## IMPORTANT!

### Maintenance and Calibration

Incorrectly setting the scissors can seriously impair the blades. If the scissors are too loose, the hair can get caught between the blades or the hair could slide off them. If they are too tight, it increases wear on the blade material. Both incorrect settings reduce the working life of the scissors and undermine their cutting properties.

With this in mind:

#### **ALWAYS ADJUST CORRECTLY!**

1. Set the scissors so loose that they close shut under their own weight.
2. Now, adjust the Akashi screw system until the blade can no longer close under its own weight and remains in place in any position (see image). The screw system can be adjusted step by step.
3. Carry out a test cut.



#### **MAINTENANCE**

Depending on use, hairdressing scissors should be cleaned and oiled several times a week. For this, we recommend the Japanese camellia oil from Akashi. The pivot point in particular (see image) should be oiled as this is where the most friction occurs.
